RIESLING LIEU-DIT SCHIEFERBERG

Stemming from vines of more than 35 years of age, the Riesling lieu-dit Schieferberg was late harvested. These old vines give a very special wine, strong and full-bodied, which ages particularly well.

TERROIR : Clay, limestone, sand
GRAPE VARIETAL : 100% Riesling
OUTPUT : 45 hl/ha
HARVEST : only manual
EXPOSITION : South, south-east

COLOR : white
TYPE : dry

ESTIMATED AGE OF THE VINES : more than 25 years
AVERAGE PLANTING DENSITY : 4800 vines/ha
AGEING : oak casks
KEEPING : 5 to 10 years.

TASTING COMMENTS : Consisted of schists, the locality Schieferberg is characterized by a strong slope directed due south. It is a country of preference for thoroughbred Rieslings and character. The Riesling lieu-dit Schieferberg opens on floral, lemony and aniseed notes. The palate distinguishes itself by a frank attack, in the notes of citrus fruits. Finale in mouth on notes of grapefruit.

VINIFICATION: Slow fermentation with controlled temperature.

FOOD AND WINE MATCHING : This Riesling accompanies perfectly seafoods, fishes and white meats
